Statement of Tuition Assurance - VET Student Loans
Diploma of Youth Work CHC50413

Tuition assurance is an arrangement between an RTO and a tuition assurance scheme operator that ensures that *"In the event of a Provider ceasing to provide a course of study, to either find an alternative place for the student with another provider or refund course fees paid by the student and/or fees paid on the student's behalf and particularly fees paid by the Commonwealth to a Provider as part of a HELP loan"* (TAFE Directors Australia)

Scripture Union Queensland (RTO 30548) has approved tuition assurance arrangements in place for the Diploma of Youth Work (CHC50413) in line with the VET Student Loans requirements as outlined in the VET Student Loans Act 2016 and VET Student Loans Rules 2016 with the following approved tuition assurance scheme operator:

If Scripture Union Queensland ceases to provide the Diploma of Youth Work while you are enrolled and before the course is completed the TAFE Directors Australia will offer affected students a replacement course in relation to the following information (VET Student Loans Rules 2016, p.47):

- Your replacement course will be with another provider (replacement provider)
- You may request review of a decision about whether a course is a suitable replacement
- If you accept the offer of a replacement course you will not be required to pay the replacement provider for the replacement components of the replacement course; and you will receive course credits for the parts of the original course successfully completed
- The tuition fees for your replacement course may be different from your original course
- You will have a period of 6 months in which to accept the offer and the tuition assurance scheme operator may extend that period in circumstances that justify an extension
- If it is deemed that there is no suitable replacement course, your FEE-HELP balance will be re-credited for the affected parts of the original course.
- If you enrol in a course that is not considered a replacement course, you may be required to pay additional tuition fees and may not be able to receive the course credits you would have received if enrolled in the replacement course.
